



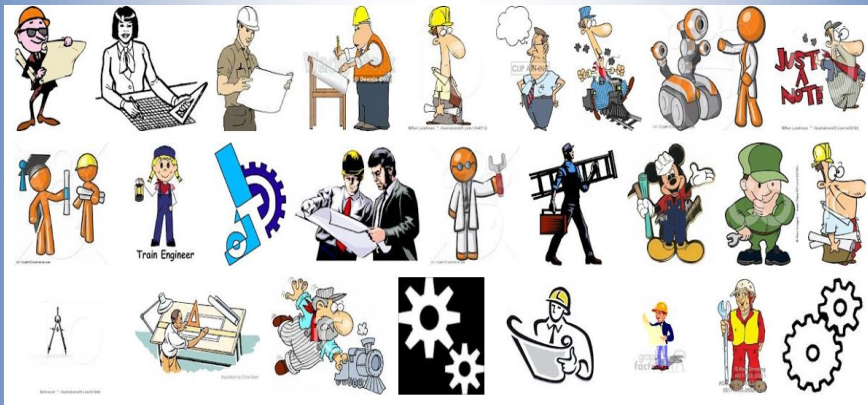

To be eligible for.....

Training For Success (Tfs) : 16-18yrs old. You will receive training and travel allowance from the college. No costs involved to student

AppNi: 16-24 and employed for a minimum of 21 hours per week. No costs involved to student. Employer incentives available on completion of qualification

FE: Over 18 with no employer or over 25. Fee's to be paid by student on enrolment of course

L1 Certificate in Building Services

- ◆ This course is designed as an introduction to Building Services Engineering. It offers participants the chance to experience and learn about plumbing, electrical and refrigeration in both theoretical and hands on practical projects. This course is perfect for those who want to learn and find out what career might suit them best or for those who want to learn about the core sectors in Building Service Engineering
- ◆ **Units Include:** Health & Safety, Science, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Electrical, Environmental Protection, Heating and Plumbing Pipework
- ◆ Part time course delivered 1 night per week over 1 year



OCN DIY Plumbing Night Class

- ◆ This 10 week course will provide participants with the skills, knowledge and confidence to carry out simple plumbing repairs around the home. Participants will complete a short portfolio of evidence and will acquire skills working on different projects and live water supplies. Particularly useful if a cold winter arrives!
- ◆ **Units include:** Isolating water supplies in the home, Repairs to toilets/cisterns/valves in the home and different methods of bending & jointing plastic & copper pipework
- ◆ Part time course delivered 1 night per week for 10 weeks

Level 2/3 Plumbing

- ◆ This course is aimed at school leavers and those who have opted for a career change and want to train as a plumber on site. The course combines theory and practical skills delivered in our well equipped workshop. Participants will learn and develop the key skills required to carry out the job role of a plumber both in college and in the workplace
- ◆ **Units include:** Health & Safety, Science, Site Preparation, Cold & Hot water systems, Heating, Drainage and Environmental Techniques
- ◆ On completion of level 2, participants can progress to level 3 and become a fully qualified plumber
- ◆ Full time course, 2 days per week along with work placement for level 2 dropping to 1 day per week with work placement for level 3

L2/L3 Refrigeration, Air Conditioning and Heat Pump Systems

- ◆ This qualification is suitable for people from a maintenance, plumbing or electrical background that wish to diversify and expand their knowledge in a different field and gain a formal qualification.
- ◆ **Units include:** Service & Maintain RAC and HP Systems, Health & Safety and Handling F gases & ozone depleting substances
- ◆ Full time or Part time option available with progression route to level 3 diploma
